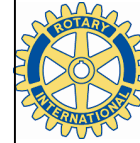

Lisa Neville's Address

Lisa spoke about what's happening on the Bellarine Peninsula and the issues and challenges going forward.

In the 8 year since she was elected she spoke about school upgrades and extension at Leopold, Drysdale, StLeonards, Ocean Grove, Point Lonsdale, Moolap and Newcomb.

Health Service improvements including increased home community care facilities and the newly opened Head Space facility supporting Youth Mental Health.

Emergency Service upgrades included new equipment for the SES and CFA, a new Ambulance station at Ocean Grove and Police station upgrades.

Other improvements included Clifton Springs Boat Harbour, the Dell, Springdale and Portarlington Neighbour centres, Bellarine Pool, Bellarine Railway, Portarlington Miniature Railway, Potato shed and street scapes. A new bus service has just commenced with 58 new services for Drysdale and Clifton Springs.
