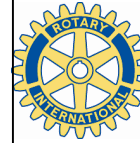


**Guest Speaker - Tim Bell -
Teaching in Arnhem land**

Tim , a retired school teacher & now a Real
Estate Salesmen, won a Teaching
Fellowship. This entitled him to a World-
wide Fellowship but he decided he preferred
to devote it to our own Australian remote
homeland.
He chose the Gove area which is a rich baux-
ite mining area that encroaches on the in-
digenous propulation & culture.

The experience he achieved proves that the
white people have absolutely no understand-
ing of the aboriginal culture & way of life by
forcing them to adopt our lifestyle. English is
only one of 7 of the languages spoken by
most of the people in this area & is only used
in the schools.

Government provides \$20 million for ser-
vices to the people - spending \$180 million
by over servicing & not reaching the aborigi-
nal settlements. Future is to retain & educate
them in their home areas.
